If You Don't Know Your Purpose...

Life is a difficult and arduous journey—so challenging and gut wrenching, many refuse to believe in God.

How could a loving God allow His prized creation to suffer? That fair question has been asked by millions of broken hearts for thousands of years.

Amidst life's perils, it's imperative to remember this vital truth:

If you don't know your purpose, you'll only know your problems.

I recently listened to a podcast about the exciting, yet exhausting life of entrepreneurs. Being in business for yourself sounds illustrious, but it's full of stressful days and sleepless nights. The speaker (who was also an entrepreneur) remarked, "In business, if you don't know your purpose, you'll only know your problems." Said in another cliché, "If you don't remember the 'why,' you'll inevitably fail at the 'what.'" Problems are guaranteed. Remembering your purpose propels you forward.

The same could and should be said for the journey of faith.

The path that Jesus paves is never easy. He expects us to count the cost (Luke 9: 57-62). He informs us that there will be troubles (John 16: 33).
