What Does the Resurrection of Jesus Mean?

There is evidence for the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

- There is written evidence. His birth record is documented all the way back to Adam. The gospels record His death, burial, and resurrection.
- There is eyewitness testimony. There were more than 500 eyewitnesses who saw Jesus after the resurrection (1 Cor. 15:5-6).
- There is physical and other evidence. The empty tomb still exists.

The modern day calendar testifies of a risen Savior separating all of time into two parts: B.C. ("Before Christ") and A.D. ("Anno Domini", which means "in the year of our Lord").

Friends, Jesus is risen from the dead – the evidence is there! Now you can still choose whether to believe it or not, but the fact that Jesus lived, died, and arose, in my mind, is incontrovertible. But what does this mean for us?

- It means that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. Paul affirmed that Christ is "declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead" (Rom. 1:4). The resurrection of Jesus is the foundation of the Christian system (cf. 1 Cor. 15:14ff).
- It means Jesus has defeated Satan and death. The resurrected Jesus stated to John, *"I am He who lives, and*

was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death." (Rev.1:18). Through His resurrection, Jesus effectively demonstrated His power over death and Satan (Heb. 2:14-15).

 It means that Jesus is coming again. Speaking concerning after His resurrection, Jesus told His disciples (and ultimately us), "I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also" (John 14:2 -3). Jesus arose from the dead so that we could one day resurrect and have life forevermore. Jesus said in John 14:19, "Because I live, you will live also."

Because Jesus is resurrected and lives, He remains Lord and can continue to reign in our lives, He continues to keep Satan and death in check, and He is coming back for His own. Hallelujah!!!
