Greater Faith?

I wish my brethren would stop saying things like, "It takes more faith to believe in evolution than in creation." I think I understand the point they're trying to make, but they're abusing the word "faith."

Long story short, accepting Darwinian evolution with all its implications doesn't require "faith" at all! It requires rejection of proven facts. For example, life comes from life. Every experiment along this line has shown that non-living matter doesn't produce life, even under the most favorable laboratory conditions. Similarly, "nothing" doesn't produce "something." Yet for the whole evolutionary scenario to be true, nothing had to get busy and become something, and that something had to switch from non-living to living, and then gradually change into more and more complex life forms (whereas changes we see in nature are invariably from the more complex to the less complex).

Belief in creation, by contrast, is consistent with what we know about the universe. Yes, it requires belief in a supernatural being we cannot see, but sound reasoning supports that conclusion. It is problematic only when people begin with the assumption that the material universe is all that exists. In other words, they rule out anything supernatural. Such assumptions are entirely unreasonable and unscientific.

Biblical faith does not contradict sound reasoning! Biblical faith does not mean we jettison observable truth! Biblical faith is not blind, but is based on evidence – evidence from God's word which is perfectly compatible with evidence from God's world.

Atheistic dogma that rejects proven facts is not faith. So, let's not denigrate faith by calling it that!




