Cultural Church Changes

When the church of Christ began in the first century there was an inevitable clash with the culture. The church was comprised of saints (1 Corinthians 1:1-2; Ephesians 5:25-27). Their values were a contrast to those of the world out of which they had, by the Gospel of Christ, been called. Greed was replaced by the joy of giving. Lust was crucified by the sense of integrity, and the profane fled from the determination to honor God and His Word.

However, the culture was not about to accept the demand for change without a fight. Tactics such as intimidation, fear,

and even physical torture were utilized in an effort to break the spirits of God's children. The saints' condemnation of an ungodly culture caused them to be subjected to wooden neck and leg stocks, beatings, torture racks, lions' dens, imprisonment, and often death.

If God's people in the first century had operated on the principle of some people in the 20th century, the book of Revelation would not have been written, because compromise with the culture would have prevented the conflict. Furthermore, the Holy Spirit would not have inspired Peter to write a book on suffering. Paul's inspired warning, "*Yea, and all who live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution*" (2 Timothy 3:12), would be meaningless language.

The culture wants change, but it wants the church to do it, according to the needs of the culture. Unfortunately the culture does not have values of quality that really enhance life now, much less offer any real hope for an eternal future. What can people who live for **NOW** exclusively offer people who want to live eternally? Silence is the answer.

Change is needed for sure. However, a God Who has all knowledge must be trusted to identify the change that is needed (Isaiah 55:8-10). The true revelation of the necessary change is found in the Bible.
