Biographical Information on Dave Miller

Since Dave Miller will be our special guest speaker for The Silencing of God Seminar which begins next Sunday night, I thought it would be good to share a few things about his professional background. He has furthered his education in order to open doors that might not have been available otherwise.

Dave Miller is a graduate of Lubbock Christian University, where he earned a B.A. degree in speech and Bible. He earned his M.A. degree in speech communication from Texas Tech University, and his Master of Theology and Master of Arts in Religion from the Harding Graduate School of Religion. He also is a graduate of Southern Illinois University, where he earned his Ph. D. in Rhetoric and Public Address. Most of all I would add that Dave Miller is a faithful Christian who has a profound love for God, the Lord Jesus Christ, His church and His Holy Word.

For over 30 years, he has served in various capacities for churches of Christ, including pulpit preacher, director of a school of preaching, and host of the nationally televised program, "The Truth in Love," which airs on GBN (gbntv.org). Presently serving as the Executive Director of Apologetics Press, bro. Miller has authored numerous articles and books, including *The Quran Unveiled*, *Sexual Anarchy*, *Piloting the Strait*, *Christ and the Continental Congress*, and a series of books that teach children how to read. He appears on lectureships and conducts weekend seminars and Gospel meetings 40-50 weekends a year. In

addition to speaking on a wide range of biblical subjects, bro. Miller specializes in presenting seminars on the topics, "The Silencing of God: The Dismantling of America's Christian Heritage," "Islam, the Quran, and New Testament Christianity," "A Trip Through the Bible," and "Must Churches of Christ Change?"
