Paul Did—Do You?

When Paul wrote his second epistle to young Timothy, one of the things he mentioned was to *"not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord"* (2 Tim. 2:8). In the following verses, Paul reminds Timothy that Jesus had saved them and, as a result, they now had a purpose in life.

Then in v.12 Paul uses himself as a great example in this. It is very interesting to note the things that Paul connects to his life and conviction:

"For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day." Even through the hardest of times, Paul never lost his faith, profession, or positive actions in Christ.

Paul believed and lived his faith to the fullest. Do you? Keep Jesus in your life and Jesus will keep you!

"Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. That good thing which was committed to you, keep by the Holy Spirit who dwells in us." (2 Tim. 2:13-14).
