

Henry Ward Beecher was a renowned 19th century preacher. He actually achieved "celebrity status" in his day. People would flock to hear him preach when he came to their community. On one occasion in Brooklyn, NY, many curiosity seekers arrived at Plymouth Church to hear the famous Henry Ward Beecher speak. However, to their dismay, Thomas Beecher, Henry's brother, rose to deliver the message that day instead. When people came to the realization that the renowned Beecher would not be speaking, they arose from their seats and headed for the doors.

Unmoved by what was happening, Thomas Beecher quickly brought things into perspective when he said, "Those of you who came here today to worship Henry Ward Beecher are excused at this time. However, those of you who came to worship God, please remain seated." Nothing more needed to be said.

Sometimes I think we may need to be reminded that when we assemble on the Lord's day, it's not to be entertained, impressed, or "wowed" by the speaker, but to worship God. When our mindset views the preacher as a the participant, and ourselves as his audience, we've lost focus. Actually, we are all the participants, and God is the audience. Instead of judging the preacher's eloquence, critiquing the song leader's selection and tempo, and timing the length of the closing prayer, it might be more helpful to consider how God is judging our performance. Give it some thought.

The Game of Life

Steve Higginbotham asks, "Have you ever played Milton Bradley's, 'The Game of LIFE?' Probably you have at some point. This game has been around a long time -- since 1860! The object of this game is to cause its players to make several important 'life decisions' and teach them several imdecisions and lessons were:

- go to college first.
- Paydays are typically better for those who go to college.
- Whether to buy or not to buy health/life insurance.
- Having children can bring benefits as well as liabilities.

Life has many unexpected setbacks, as well as serendipitous blessings. And ultimately, the decisions you make in life will determine whether you will wind up in a "Millionaire's Mansion" or the "Poor House."

Then Higginbotham points out an important lesson that one can learn from the game even though it's not found in the game's instructions: "But one lesson this game didn't teach us; in fact, the most important lesson of all is this...

When the game is over, everything goes back in the box!

No matter how good you were at this game; no matter how much money you were able to accumulate; no matter whom you were able to beat; at the end of the game, you had to put everything you had accumulated back in the box."

Higginbotham's observations illustrate the truthfulness of this passage:

"For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out." - 1 Timothy 6:7

"No matter what you're able to accomplish in life; no matter how much monportant 'life lessons,' while having fun ev you are able to earn in your lifetime; all at the same time. Some of those no matter how many people you competed against and over which you were • Whether to go straight to work, or victorious; when your life is over, it all goes 'back in the box.' You take none of it with you. Then you'll stand before your Maker." - Steve Higginbotham

> If we've spent all of our time, energy, and focus on things that "go back into the box," we will perish and miss out on the greatest, ETERNAL blessings that God wants to give to us. Please read Matthew 6:19-21.

> Our sins condemn us (Romans 6:23), but God loves us so much that He gave His Son Jesus to die on the cross for our sins so that we might receive forgiveness and the gift of eternal life (Romans 6:23).

> God will save those who place their faith and trust in Christ (Acts 16:30-31), turn from their sins in repentance (Acts 17:30-31), confess Jesus before men (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized (immersed) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38). (next page)
