2. Laziness. Obtaining and using an actual hitch would have taken time and effort, not to mention money. Ah, just use a chain. It'll probably be ok.

Ignorance and laziness can get us into trouble in matters of the spirit, too. When it comes to God's word, ignorance definitely isn't bliss! *"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge"* (Hosea 4:6). Not less than fourteen times in the New Testament Jesus and the inspired writers challenged people with the words, *"Do you not know?"*

Laziness can also cost you your soul! The slothful one talent man was cast into outer darkness (Matthew 25:30).

And Hebrews 6:12 warns us not to be slothful, but to *"imitate those who, through faith and patience, inherit the promises."*
