

A Better Idea

Over half a century ago (1968 to be exact) Ford Motor Company began a new advertising campaign using the slogan "Ford has a better idea." It featured the image of a glowing light bulb and urged listeners and viewers to "see the light!" No doubt Ford's engineers had some good ideas. Others, not so much. The snarky side of me has gotten guite a bit of mileage mocking the "better idea" of things I found subpar in the Ford vehicles I've owned. In those cases, I obviously think my own ideas are better than Ford's! You might or might not agree.

Neither you nor I will ever have better ideas than God has. King Saul thought he had a better idea of what to do with the king and livestock of Amalek. God told Saul to utterly destroy them. Saul brought back the king and the best of the livestock, supposedly to sacrifice the animals to the Lord. Wouldn't just destroying them all be a waste? Wouldn't sacrificing them be a better idea? The prophet Samuel answered: "Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22).

God has graciously provided a way for sinners to be saved. When a lost person puts his confident trust in Jesus as the Son of God, repents of sin, and is immersed in water for the remission of sins, God washes that person's sins away in the blood of Christ. The book of Acts is replete with examples. According to some, however, there is a better way: Pray the "sinner's prayer" and invite Jesus into your heart! (Don't bother looking for Scripture that teaches it!)

Then there's that thorny subject of baptism. The very word means "immersion," but people have decided sprinkling and pouring are better ideas.

You can think of other examples. But far and away the best idea is to trust and obey the Lord!

A Faith That Sings

Psalm 98:1-3 and 8-9 says, 1 Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! For He has done marvelous things; His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him the victory. 2 The Lord has made known His salvation; His righteousness He has revealed in the sight of the nations. 3 He has remembered His mercy and His faithfulness to the house of Israel; all the ends of the Earth have seen the salvation of our God. 8 Let the rivers clap their hands, let the mountains sing together for joy; 9 for He is coming to judge the Earth. With righteousness He shall judge the world, and the peoples with equity.

When Paul and Silas were beaten and imprisoned in the city of Philippi, God's

word tells us they "were praying and singing hymns to God" in Acts 16:25. Christians ought to be singing people. "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teach and admonish one another in all wisdom, and sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs with thankfulness in your hearts to God," writes Paul in Colossians 3:16. We are admonished in the word of God to sing to the Lord. "Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! For He has done marvelous things; His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him the victory" (verse 1 above).

Sing about God's victories. If you In the meantime, I will continue to preach think you have no victory in your life, start singing about the victory of the Lord, and you'll be surprised what He'll do for you. Sing about His salvation. "The Lord has made known His salvation; His righteousness He has revealed in the sight of the nations" (verse 2 above). We should proclaim the message of salvation to people today.

> Sing about His mercy and faithfulness. "He has remembered His mercy and His faithfulness" (verse 3 above). The Lord's mercy and faithfulness endure forever. Sing about His coming. Verse 9 tells us, "for He is coming to judge the Earth. With righteousness He shall judge the world, and the peoples with equity." Sing about His coming, for Jesus may come back today!

> Are you singing the praises of God in your life? If you've lost your song, it may mean that you've lost your vision of God and your faith in His word. Perhaps sin has come into your life. Follow the instructions of this psalm and by faith "sing to the Lord a new song."
