The Fortune of Family

One of the most valuable things that God has given us is the concept of the family. Think about it – before God brought forth the societal governmental system, He gave the family. Before God established His church on the earth, He consecrated the family.

After creating the heavens and the earth, God placed a family there (Gen. 1:27-28; 2:21-25). After God cleansed the earth through the global flood, He began anew with a family (Gen. 6:17-18.). The family as God would have it is the moral structure of any successful society. The family is the golden thread that binds a particular group of people to their past, present, and future. Friendship

Genuine friendship is one of the deepest hungers of the human heart. We innately seek out friends who have understanding, love and unwavering loyalty. True friendship is too rare and too precious to neglect, too infrequent to forget, and too sacred to carelessly cast away.

Jeremy Taylor wrote, *"By friendship you mean the greatest love, the greatest usefulness, the most open communication, the noblest sufferings, the severest truth, the heartiest counsel, and the greatest union of minds of which brave men and women are capable."* The value of friendship is truly tremendous. Euripides said, *"Life has no blessing like a prudent friend."* Oliver Wendell Holmes wrote, *"Fame is the senseless sunflower with gaudy crown of gold; but friendship is the breathing rose, with sweets in every fold."*

Proverbs 17:17 says, *"A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity."* A little later in the book of Proverbs we see a further parallel between a "friend" and a "brother": *"There are friends who pretend to be friends, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother"* (18:24).
